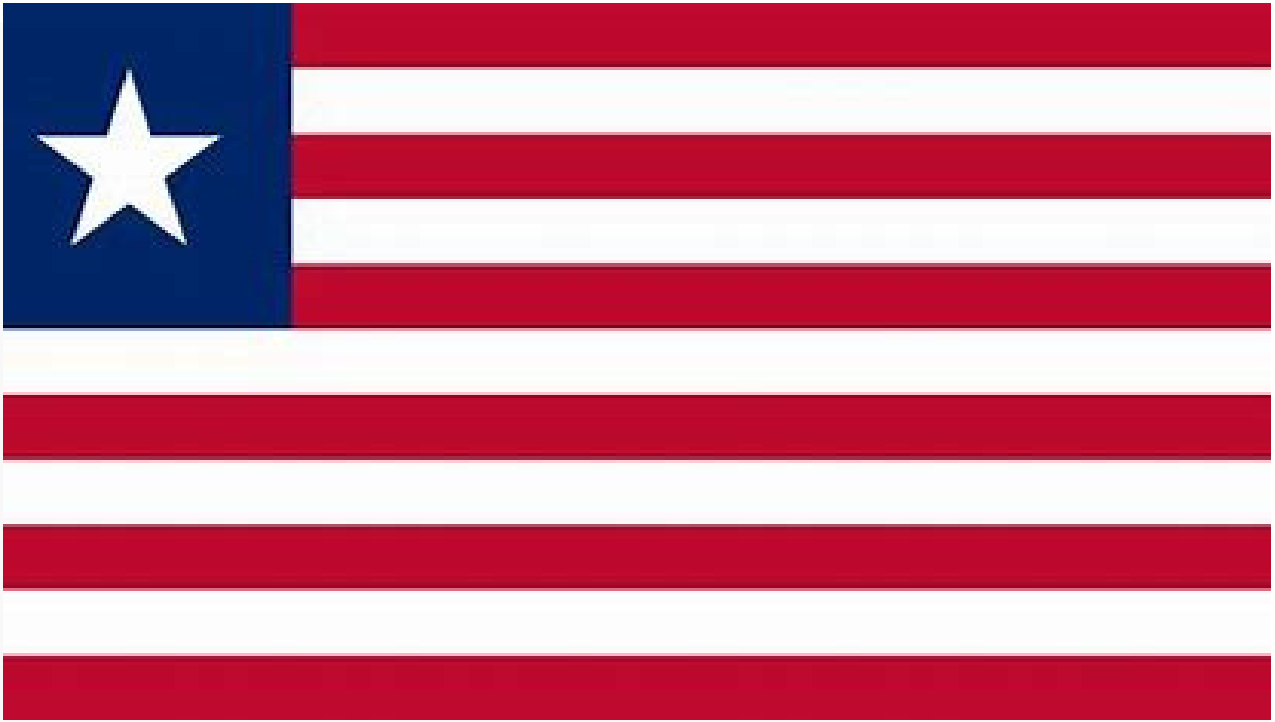

OUR STORY: A JOURNEY OF VISION, IMPACT, AND TRANSFORMATION

It began with a dream—simple, yet bold: to transform Africa by raising a new generation of ethical, creative, and transformative leaders. That dream became GonetAfrica, a youth-led organization with a clear mission: to equip and empower young people and professionals to become the change Africa needs.

In February 2021, GonetAfrica started with small youth events—bringing young people together to learn, network, and share ideas. We paid one month’s rent for a co-working space at iCampus. When it came time to pay for the second month, our founder withdrew money from his personal account, bought tea and bread at a local shop on Randall Street, and headed to the office in Monrovia. To his shock, the money had disappeared. Speechless and heartbroken, he left the office—but not the vision.

Instead, we pivoted to hosting online events, staying committed to our mission even when resources were limited. Later that same year, a partnership was established with the A.M. Kyne Collegiate Resource Center on 12th Street within the William V.S. Tubman High School. We moved in and hosted impactful programs centered around youth empowerment.

Birth of Gonet Academy

In June 2022, our work gave birth to Gonet Academy—created to equip, empower, and elevate professionals through continuous learning and professional development. What started with a few programs quickly grew into something remarkable.

To date, we’ve completed 12 cohorts, empowering over 4,00 professionals from 500+ institutions across all 15 counties of Liberia. More than 3,000 young people, women and persons with disabilities have been impacted through different programs and projects, with majority being female. This milestone marks a powerful testament to our commitment to inclusive growth and professional excellence.

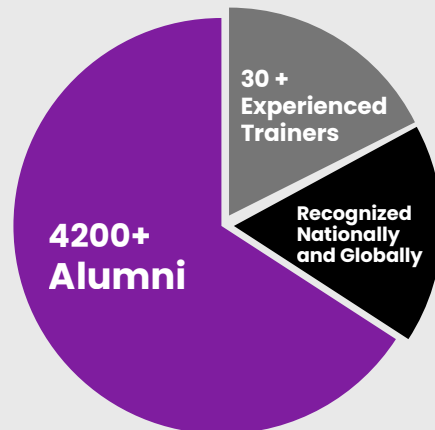
